SCHOOL/COMMUNITY INFORMATION

- John Handley High School is a privately endowed public high school.
- 1200 students in grades 9-12
- John Handley High School is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Jeffersonian architecture and beautifully landscaped campus make it one of the region's showplaces.

CURRICULUM AND PROGRAMS

- The curriculum at John Handley High School is designed to provide students with a comprehensive offering of academic and career/technical courses. The strong instructional program is complemented by a wide range of athletic and co-curricular activities.
- John Handley HS operates on a 4 X 4 block schedule.
- **Advanced Placement (AP)** – College-level coursework
 - English – Language and Composition, Literature and Composition
 - Social Science – World History, US History, US Government and Politics
 - Math – Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics
 - Science – Biology, Chemistry, Physics C: Mechanics, Physics C: E and M, Environmental Science
 - Foreign Language – German Language and Culture; French Language and Culture; Spanish Language and Culture, Spanish Literature, Latin
 - Fine Art – Studio Art
- John Handley High School offers college-preparatory course work through differentiated instruction in mathematics, science and social studies. Beginning in 2013-14 honors level courses began being offered for English 1 and 2 only.
- **Dual Enrollment (DE)** – John Handley High School offers nearly thirty dual enrollment courses through Lord Fairfax Community College, James Madison University and Shenandoah University in the core academic and career/technical areas. All sections of the courses below are taught at the college level and students may opt-in to receive college credit.
 - English – AP English Language, AP English Literature
 - Social Science – AP World History, AP US History, AP US Government
 - Math – Calculus, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Statistics
 - Science – AP Biology, AP Chemistry
 - Foreign Language – German IV, AP German Language and Culture; French IV, AP French Language and Culture
 - Career/Technical Education – CIS, Adv. CIS, Medical Systems Administration, Multimedia/Web Tech; Intro. Medical Sciences, Medical Terminology; Computer Systems Tech. I/II; Electronic Systems I/II; Welding I
- **VHS (Virtual High School) Collaborative** – Students may select from a variety of course options and earn high school credit through a co-synchronous e-learning model.
- **Mountain Vista Governor's School (MVGS)** - The mission of the Mountain Vista Governor's School is to present a research-based, technology-enhanced, integrated program in mathematics, science, and the humanities. The program will challenge students to reach their full potential as independent thinkers capable of assuming leadership roles in a constantly changing global society.

CLASS RANK/GRADE POINT AVERAGE CALCULATION

- Students attending John Handley High School who are enrolled in Advanced Placement courses; courses that prepare the student to take a corresponding Advanced Placement exam; and/or Mountain Vista Governor's School courses will receive additional weighted quality points to be added to the base GPA. Students will receive an additional 0.17 quality points added to the base GPA for each weighted course passed.
